Weekend Workshop

Jan. 7-8 - Build Your Own Toboggan:

All tools and materials provided for this exciting class. Learn about the type of wood being used while preparing staves for steam bending the first day. For assembly on the second day, attach cross bars using hand peened copper rivets, standard wood screws and copper clench nails, along with the rope and any other final touches. Everyone will leave with a finished 8' long toboggan!

Mar. 10 - 1-Day Black Ash Basketry:



During this one day workshop participants will learn the fundamentals of this form of splint work. Types of baskets, history and stories will be shared and discussed through out the day while participants weave a small basket of their own to take home.

Mar. 24 - Scandinavian Style Spoon Carving:



While carving a fine eating spoon participants will learn: the tools and their care; the preferred wood for spoons; proper spoon design (based on the long standing Scandinavian spoon carving tradition); carving techniques and knife use; and sanding and finishing. Spoons will be carved out of roughed out spoon blanks with a variety of woods from which to choose. Craftsmanship and attention to detail will be stressed.

Workshop instructors are April and Jarrod Stone Dahl owners of *WOODSPIRIT*. April is a member of the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa and currently the only black ash basket weaver of her band. April takes great pride in weaving quality utilitarian baskets which are meant to be used.

Jarrod is of Scandinavian descent, and much of his woodworking style is influenced by this. His passion is pre-industrial woodworking techniques using primarily hand tools.
